**Secure Export Container Seals**


I am writing to formally advise of the approval of a Mega Lock MCL-250 high security container seal, with a green bolt and red locking hasp, for use on container exports by SES partners who also require to have their export containers sealed for New Zealand Food Safety Authority (NZFSA) purposes.

This approval has come about as a result of agreement between ourselves and NZFSA colleagues, and will prevent duplication in the affixing of security seals on export containers for a number of SES partners, both current and, hopefully, future. The use of a single seal for government sealing requirements should also prove most useful in the compilation of export documentation, where the incorporation of a single unique identifier will alleviate any confusion.

The only change to current distribution procedures is that in respect to this particular seal, NZFSA will source it from your company and in turn provide supplies to SES exporters, rather than SES partners sourcing their requirements direct from your company, as is the case with other Customs-approved seals.

Attached for your information are draft copies of my notification letters to our SES partners, the Ports, CBAFF, and the NZFSA. These letters will be in the post before the end of this week.
